



***Day End Championships will be given to the high point riders in each division:**

Green Horse WTJ, E&W – 3 12 19 24 41
13 and Under WTJ, E & W – 4 13 20 25 42
14 and Over WTJ, E & W – 5 14 21 26 43
English 17 and under WTC – 7 15 22 27 44
English, 18 and over WTC – 8 16 23 28 45
Western 17 and under, WJL – 7 32 35 37 46
Western 18 and over, WJL – 8 33 36 38 47

Divisions and Class Descriptions:

- *Open classes** – Riders who canter or lope may enter an Open WTJ class but riders who only WTJ may not enter an Open class that asks horses to canter (with the exception of the WTJ Performance/Individual Canter class).
- *In Hand** – This in hand class judges the overall build and condition of the horse based on their breed.
- *Halter Champion for the day** – The top 2 mares and geldings from the in-hand classes will be judged. No fee to enter.
- *Halter Buckle Series** – The horse at the end of the season with the most halter points will win a buckle.
- *Showmanship** – This in hand class may ask the horse to perform a pattern including walk, trot, halt, set-up, back and pivot.
- *CSC Showmanship Buckle Series** – Open to all. At the end of the season, the person with the highest number of points will receive a buckle. This will be awarded at our End of the Year Banquet.
- *Schooling WTJ** – Green horses and WTJ riders will have the opportunity to use the ring to school while being judged. The announcer will direct the riders to walk and trot in both directions, as well as backing their horses.
- *Three gait schooling** – Horses and riders that canter/lope will have the opportunity to use the ring to school while being judged. The announcer will direct the riders to WTC in both directions, as well as back up.
- *Green WTJ** – Horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing that are considered green. Combined English/Western. Walk/trot/jog only. The same horse rider combination may not enter any class that asks rider to canter/lope.
- *13 and Under WTJ** – Riders 13 years or younger. Walk/trot/jog only. Combined English/Western. The same horse/rider combination may not enter any class that asks the rider to canter or lope.
- *14 and Over WTJ** – Riders 14 years of age or older. Walk/trot/jog only. Combined English/Western. The same horse/rider combination may not enter any class that asks the rider to canter or lope.
- *Open WTJ Performance/Individual Canter** – Open to any rider who would like to get mileage schooling at the canter/lope without being in a large group. The class will WTJ in a group, then canter/lope ½ of the ring individually, in both directions. English/Western combined. Judged on the overall performance of the horse/rider.
- *17 and under (English, Western) WTC** – For riders under 18 yrs. as of January 1st who are comfortable cantering or loping.
- *18 and Over (English, Western) WTC** – Riders who are 18 years or older as of January 1st who are comfortable cantering or loping.
- *Lead Line** – For riders 6 years and under who need to be led. Lead line riders cannot enter any other class.
- *English Bridle Path Hack and Western Road Hack** – In addition to the standard gaits of WTCL, riders will be asked to extend the canter/lope. Riders are expected to have control of their mounts at all times.
- *Pattern Classes** – Each rider will individually perform a class appropriate pattern. There will be no rail work.
- *WTJ Bareback Simon Says Fun Class** – Ridden without a saddle, pad or chaps. Rider must only change gaits when the announcer gives a command beginning with Simon Says or they will be eliminated.
- *Trail** – Run at will on outside course, beginning at 930. Will consist of 7-10 obstacles. 3 attempts per obstacle.
- *In Hand Trail** – Riders will lead their horses through a series of 7-10 obstacles from the ground. 3 attempts per obstacle. Halters are to be used vs bridles and the horse/pony should be led without tack on.
- *CSC Trail Buckle Series** – All riders are eligible. There will only be gaits of WTJ but the course will be more of a challenge than the regular trail classes per divisions. At the end of the season, the high point rider will receive a buckle. This will be awarded at the End of the Year banquet.
